- 2 doses, separated by at least 4 weeks, for children age 6 months-8 years who are receiving influenza vaccine for the first time or have received <2 influenza vaccine doses.
- 1 dose for children age 6 months-8 years who have received at least 2 influenza vaccine doses.
- 1 dose for all persons age 9 years or older.

*HPV (Human Papilloma Virus):

- If initial vaccination before age 15: 2-dose series at 0 and 6-12 months.
- If initial vaccination at age 15 years or older: 3-dose series at 0, 1–2 months, and 6 months.
